SPELLBOOK by Cheryl Clingen August 2010

Thanks to various books I've read and to Lisa Maarten for her creative mind.

You will need:

- Metal ruler and craft knife to cut paper
- Pencil
- Paint brush
- Tacky glue
- Thin card 40mm × 36mm
- Piece of thin leather or distressed (poor thing) embossed paper slightly larger than card
- 5-6 pieces of thin paper approx 36mm x 32mm
- Printed top page on thin paper and cut to same size as blank pages.
- Gold felt tip pen or gold paint

METHOD

Mix all together and make a book as follows:

Glue card to middle of leather or embossed paper.

Fold edges over, fold corners in, and glue neatly (as you would cover a book)

Distress paper if you like with a bit of dry-brushing with light brown paint.

Fold each piece of thin paper in half lengthways.

One by one, glue fold to center.

Holding pages together, paint edges of papers gold.

When complete, glue each page down previous page one at a time, bending it slightly as shown in picture.

When all done, fold spell page in half and glue into place.

Make it look more realistic by bending or folding a corner up.

(Don't forget to paint the top page's edges gold.)

Your spell book is done.
